

New Zealand Red Cross Safe Driver Agreement Form

New Zealand Red Cross (NZRC) and our people who drive for NZRC have a legal duty to make sure the activity is safe and free from harm as far a reasonably possible. This includes our employees, volunteers, members and contractors who drive either NZRC fleet vehicles and / or personal vehicles to undertake NZRC activities.

1. Driver licence details

To drive for NZRC you must be over the age of 18 and hold a valid New Zealand driver licence, (or legal equivalent) for the correct class of vehicle.

2. Driving for NZRC Requirements

The NZRC <u>Safe-Driving-policy-August-2022</u> and <u>Safe Driving Guidelines</u> outline the steps that NZRC and our drivers must take to keep themselves and everyone safe.

If you drive for NZRC you must acknowledge you have read and agree to comply with these documents.

I acknowledge I have read and agree to comply with all requirements of the <u>NZRC Safe Driving Policy</u> and have read the <u>Safe Driving Guidelines</u>. I will advise my People Leader as soon as there is a change in any circumstances, including health conditions or use of medication which could affect my ability to drive safely and/or any outstanding matters e.g. Driving offences.

I understand the information contained in this agreement will be held in confidence for the purposes of ensuring health, safety and wellbeing when driving for NZRC.
